

The internationalisation of prehospital education: A merging of ideologies between Australia and the USA

The aim of this project was to foster internationalisation of prehospital education collaboratively between students and teachers from EMS Education and Training, Montana, United States of America (USA) and Monash University Centre for Ambulance and Paramedic Studies (MUCAPS), Victoria, Australia. The project required students and teachers to engage in a series of face-to-face lectures (F2F) that was reinforced through distance education strategies such as online learning. Whilst each process was pedagogically separate, an educational synergy was created providing an international perspective which was anticipated to facilitate professional success with global competence.
